We currently offer a number of exciting opportunities for qualified lay women and men interested in studying theology and preparing for ministry.

- ◆ The Aquinas Scholars Program offers up to eight fully-funded Master's level scholarships annually. These full-time residential scholarships include full-tuition funding, stipends for living expenses and books, and the option for a work study position.
- The Haciendo Caminos Program, made possible by a grant from the Lilly Foundation, allows Aquinas Institute to offer \$10,000/year of additional funding to U.S. born or U.S. raised Hispanic students for the next three academic years. Students who self-identify as Hispanic or Latinx are automatically eligible for this funding.

Students in the Aquinas Scholars and *Haciendo Caminos* programs have the option of earning a Master of Divinity (MDiv), a Master of Arts in Theology (MA), or a Master of Arts in Pastoral Studies (MAPS) degree, depending on their interests and future career plans.

Aquinas Institute offers rigorous academic programs in a student-centered environment. Our students enjoy small class sizes, personalized support, and many spiritual and social resources within our close-knit community. Through a cooperative agreement with Saint Louis University, our students have access to the academic and extracurricular benefits of a major university.
